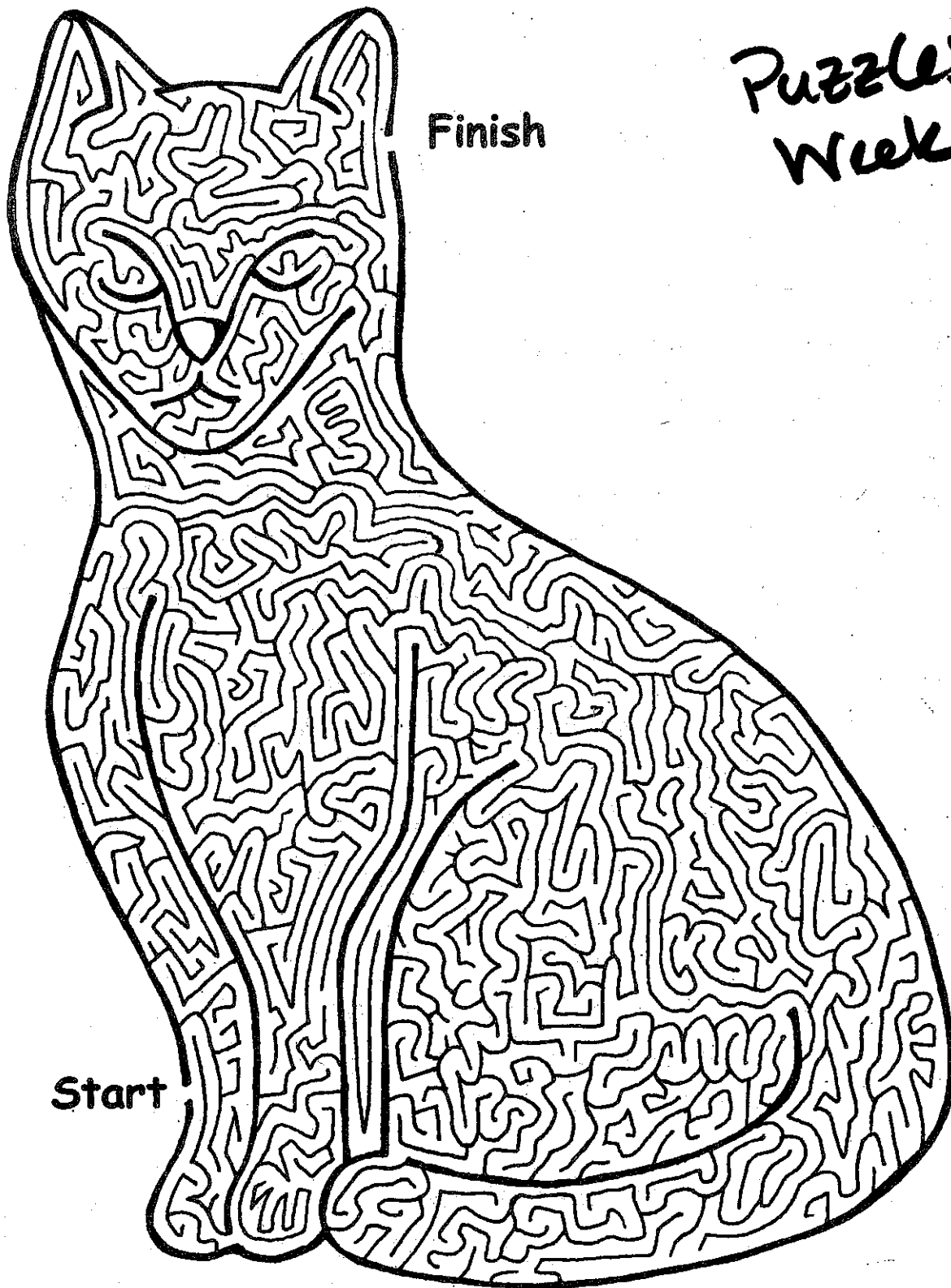

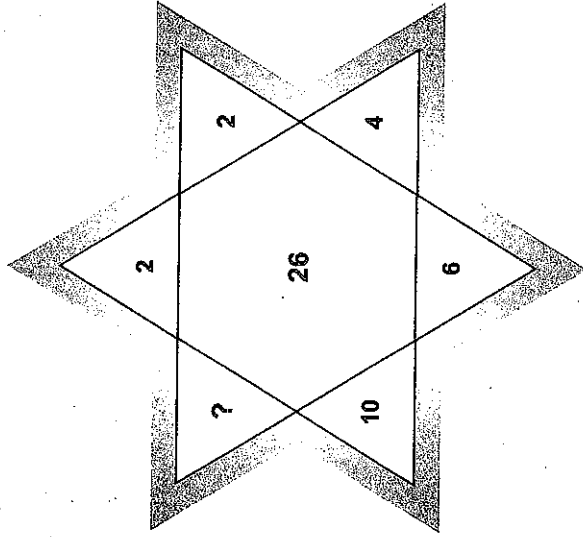

LOGIC PROBLEM 2

A Fishy Story

Myron loves every type of fish, and believes that eating it daily has endowed him with extraordinary health. Recently, he has had dinner with five different friends, and has ordered a different fish entrée for each meal. He associates each type of fish with a different type of well-being. Discover, for each type of fish Myron feasted on, the type of effect he associates with it, and the name of the friend with whom Myron ate.

- Four of the types of fish are: the fish he ate with Abigail, the fish he dined on with Neil, the fish that he credits with the onset of a peaceful mood, and the fish Myron feels enhances his singing voice.
- He associates the type of fish he had with Todd (which is either trout or salmon) with either sharp vision or an enhanced singing voice.
- Either Myron ate the fish that he associates with clear thought with a woman, or this fish is cod, or both.
- Myron didn't have fresh flounder with Grace or Olga, nor does he associate flounder with clear thought or energy.
- He doesn't credit trout with an enhanced singing voice.
- Either Myron ate peppered perch with Olga or he ate the fish he associates with a peaceful mood with Grace.
- Either he feasted on cod with Neil or he ate Trout Almondine with Olga.
- Myron ate the type of fish that he credits with providing energy with one of his women friends.
- Of flounder and salmon, he had one with a man and one with a woman.

This chart can help you solve the problem. Enter all of the facts you can from the information given by using a check for a definite "yes" and a cross for a definite "no." Once you have a definite "yes," put a cross in all the other boxes in the row and column (up to a heavy line) that contain the check. By process of elimination, you will arrive at the correct solution.

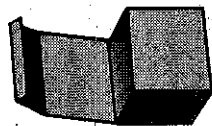

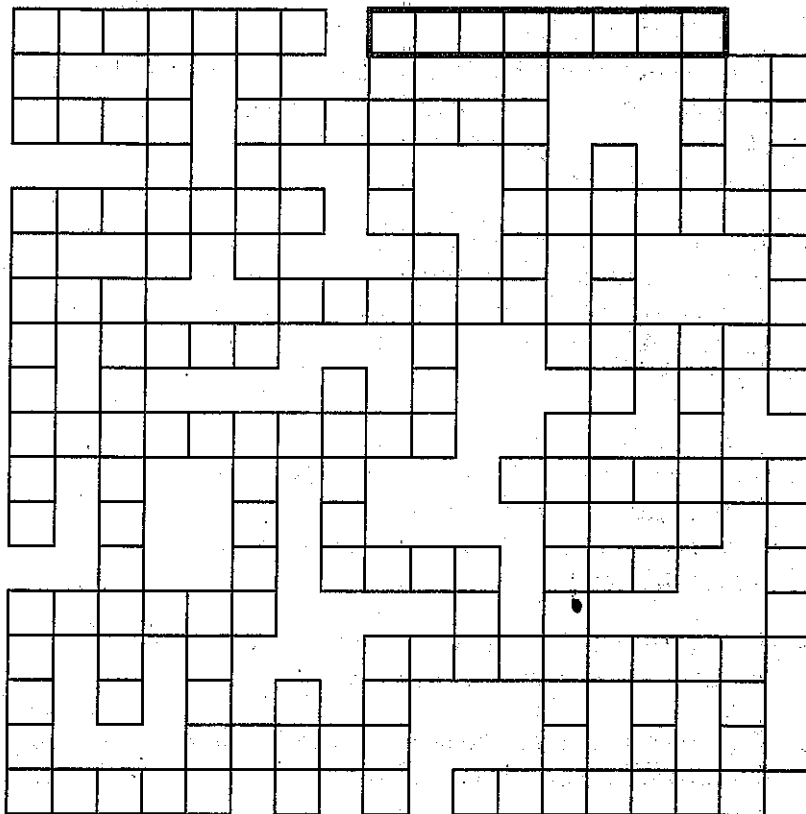

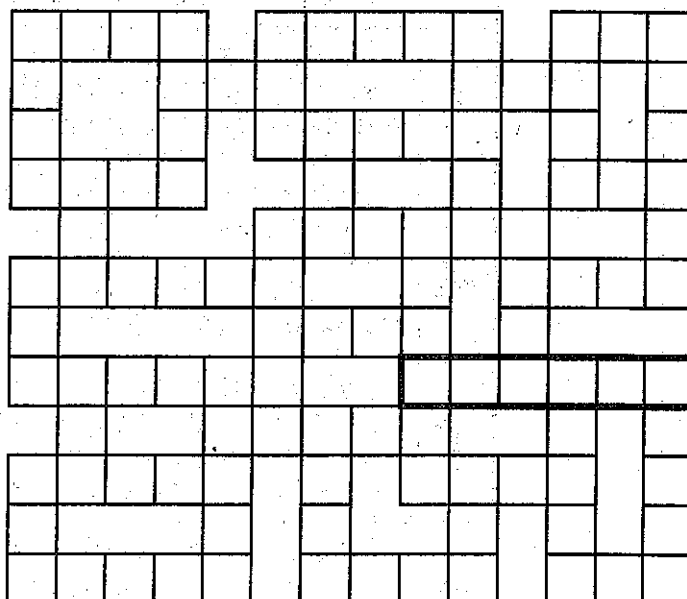
